This event was an un-permitted march and demonstration in the Downtown Los Angeles (DTLA) area. Various groups gathered in the DTLA area. Groups were volatile throwing projectiles at Officers, launching fireworks, and attempting to go onto the freeways. There were numerous Dispersal Orders given by Officers at various locations throughout the incident. The crowds failed to follow the Dispersal Orders staying in the area and throwing miscellaneous objects at Officers. There were reported NCUOF as a result of these actions.
