SUBJECT: REQUEST FOR 2026 INTERNATIONAL ASSOCIATION OF CHIEFS OF POLICE (IACP) PRESENTATION PROPOSALS AND SUBMISSION GUIDELINES

The Department is preparing for the International Association of Chiefs of Police (IACP) 2026 Annual Conference and Exposition. To ensure consistent representation and appropriate internal review, no Department employee or command may submit any proposal directly to IACP without prior approval from the Chief of Staff (COS). Commands interested in submitting a topic for consideration shall prepare an Intradepartmental Correspondence, Form 15.02.00, and route it to Training Bureau for review and approval from the COS.

Each Form 15.02.00 submission shall include:

1. Proposed presentation topic that provides a clear and specific title, reflecting the focus of the proposed session.
2. Total number of presenters, including their names, ranks/titles, and assignments.

Note: The IACP allows up to six presenters maximum.

3. Provide a one to two paragraph session summary that addresses:
 - The purpose and scope of the presentation;
 - Key concepts, practices, or innovations to be discussed; and
 - The relevance and benefit to the law enforcement profession.

Commands are encouraged to reference the previous⁴⁵ years' IACP Call for Proposals for structure, thematic areas, and content expectations to ensure proposals reflect national best practices and evidence-based approaches.

All submissions must be received by Training Bureau no later than Friday, January 23, 2026 to allow sufficient time for internal evaluation and final selection. Only proposals formally approved by the COS will be authorized for submission to IACP. If approved, personnel will need to submit an application **and** be selected by IACP as presenters.
