**SUBJECT:** CALIFORNIA ASSEMBLY BILL 466 – VEHICLES: VIOLATIONS

**PURPOSE**

The purpose of this Notice is to advise Department personnel regarding new legislation from California Assembly Bill (AB) 466, which amends California Vehicle Code (CVC) Sections 40000.25 and 42005 (e), “Failure to Attend Court-Ordered Traffic Violator School” by removing any additional penalties for their failure to comply with attending court-ordered traffic violator school.

**BACKGROUND**

Effective January 1, 2024, AB 466 removes a violation of CVC Section 42005(e) from the list of traffic offenses that shall constitute misdemeanors.

A Chief of Detectives (COD) Notice was published on July 25, 2013, titled *Los Angeles City Attorney Revised Filing Guidelines for Direct Citations*. That Notice, which has not been revised, included a three-page attachment which listed numerous Business and Profession Code Sections, Penal Code Sections, Health and Safety Code Sections, Los Angeles Municipal Code Sections, and Vehicle Code Sections that officers may cite violators as an infraction on a Notice to Appear, including CVC Section 42005.

**PROCEDURES**

Effective January 1, 2024, officers shall not apply this 2013 COD Notice to CVC Section 42005 and shall discontinue citing or arresting violators of this provision. A revised Detective Bureau Notice is forthcoming.
