DEPARTMENT NATIONAL GUARD LIAISON OFFICER

Effective immediately, the Assistant Commanding Officer, Counter-Terrorism and Special Operations Bureau (CTSOB), will assume the function of the Department National Guard Liaison Officer (NGLO). The NGLO is responsible for:

- Developing and maintaining a liaison between the Department and California National Guard; and,
- Developing a training curriculum to be provided as needed to command staff to ensure familiarity with mobilization procedures (as they pertain to Mutual Aid responses) and National Guard roles and rules of engagement during urban deployment.

Certain critical incidents involving the City of Los Angeles will trigger the activation of the Federal Bureau of Investigation's (FBI) Critical Incident Response Group (i.e., terrorist attack, mass casualty event). During such an event, the Assistant Commanding Officer of CTSOB will be assigned to the FBI's Strategic Information Operations Center and will be unavailable for Department NGLO duties; an alternate shall be designated by the Director of Emergency Operations at the Department Operations Center (DOC).
