**SUBJECT:** DISPOSITION CODE FOR FEDERAL IMMIGRATION ENFORCEMENT ACTION – ESTABLISHED

The purpose of this Notice is to inform Department personnel of the updated protocols when documenting calls for service related to Federal Immigration Enforcement Action (FIEA). In response to the ongoing immigration enforcement actions across the City of Los Angeles, Mayor Karen Bass signed Executive Directive 17, which establishes reporting mandates for all Department entities responding to incidents involving FIEA.

The Information Technology Bureau (ITB) added the disposition code, *FIEA*, *FIEASY (Supervisor Yes)*, and *FIEASN (Supervisor No)*, to the PremierOne (Computer Aided Dispatch) software installed in the Mobile Data Computer in patrol vehicles. Effective immediately, personnel shall use the appropriate disposition code upon completion of incidents involving federal immigration enforcement.

Department personnel shall handle incidents related to FIEA consistent with the Office of the Chief of Police Notice, *Response to Incidents Involving Federal Immigration Enforcement Actions – Revised*, dated March 3, 2026.
