SUBJECT: ARREST PROCEDURES FOR ALL OFFENSES DURING ZERO-BAIL EMERGENCY ORDERS; AND, ZERO-BAIL IMPACT ASSESSMENT CHECKLIST AND ZERO BAIL IMPACT ASSESSMENT TRACKING LOG – RESCINDED

On June 30, 2022, the Los Angeles County Superior Court (Court) rescinded the Third Los Angeles County Emergency Bail Schedule Modification and resumed its normal operations. All arrests will be guided by the 2022 Felony Bail Schedule and the 2022 Bail Schedule for Infractions and Misdemeanors.

Effective immediately, this Notice rescinds the Office of the Chief of Police Notice, *Arrest Procedures for all Offenses during Zero-Bail Emergency Orders; and, Zero-Bail Impact Assessment Checklist and Zero Bail Impact Assessment Tracking Log – Established*, dated March 18, 2021, and deactivates the Zero-Bail Impact Assessment Checklist and the Zero-Bail Impact Assessment Tracking Log. Moreover, the procedures and responsibilities related to the Zero-Bail Impact Assessment, including the completion of the Zero-Bail Impact Assessment Checklist, Zero-Bail Impact Assessment Tracking Log, and Zero-Bail Impact Assessment Tracking Matrix, will no longer be required.
