SUBJECT: DUTY TO COMPLETE AN AUTOMATED FIELD DATA REPORT -
REMINDER

During a recent review of complaints at Internal Affairs Division and audit findings from the Ethics Enforcement Section, Special Operations Division, Professional Standards Bureau determined that Automated Field Data Reports (AFDRs) are not consistently being completed to record a detention or search. The Department requires the completion of AFDRs to comply with state law mandates and to produce internal reports and analyses.

Therefore, this Notice is a reminder that Department Manual Section 4/202.02 requires:

Sworn personnel assigned to any field, specialized, or investigative assignment (e.g., patrol, task force, detective, and plain clothes assignments) **shall** complete an Automated Field Data Report (AFDR), Form 15.52.00, for **every person detained or searched** regardless of the initial reason for the encounter...

Although the complete policy—and its limited exceptions—are found in Department Manual Section 4/202.02, officers must be cognizant that this policy requires the completion of an AFDR even when responding to a radio call or citizen call wherein a detention or a search is made.

Additionally, although current policy allows for the completion of an AFDR by the officer's End of Watch, an upcoming Special Order will require AFDR completion immediately after the encounter is completed. Professional Standards Bureau recommends that officers begin immediate AFDR completion as a best practice, until the revised Special Order is finalized.
