SUBJECT: CLARIFICATION REGARDING MEDICAL INABILITY TO MEET
DEPARTMENT FIREARM QUALIFICATION STANDARDS


This Notice serves as clarification of the Medical Inability to Meet Department Firearm Qualification Standards per Department Manual Section 3/258.03. As a result of firearms range closures from March 16, 2020 to May 1, 2021 due to the COVID-19 Pandemic, there has been some confusion regarding the onset date for the requirement to qualify within a calendar year following a medical exemption.

Per the Chief of Police, due to the range closures from March 16, 2020 to May 1, 2021, the calendar year for those officers with prior medical exemptions shall be calculated from the date the ranges were reopened, May 1, 2021.
