**Holiday Safety Tips**

- WHEN YOU SHOP AT NIGHT, PLEASE PARK IN WELL-LIGHTED AREAS.
- KEEP ALL CAR DOORS LOCKED AND WINDOWS CLOSED IN OR OUT OF YOUR CAR.
- LOCK YOUR PACKAGES AND GIFTS IN YOUR VEHICLE'S TRUNK.
- DO NOT LEAVE ANY VISIBLE PACKAGES ON THE SEAT OF YOUR CAR. THIS CREATES AN UNNECESSARY TEMPTATION FOR THE THIEVES.
- WHEN APPROACHING AND LEAVING YOUR VEHICLE BE AWARE OF YOUR SURROUNDINGS.
- IF YOU GO OUT FOR THE EVENING, TURN ON YOUR LIGHTS AND RADIO OR TV, SO THE HOUSE OR APARTMENT APPEARS TO BE OCCUPIED. BE EXTRA CAUTIOUS ABOUT LOCKING DOORS AND WINDOWS WHEN YOU LEAVE YOUR HOME.
- DO NOT APPROACH YOUR CAR ALONE IF THERE ARE SUSPICIOUS PEOPLE STANDING BY.
