SUBJECT: TEMPORARY SUSPENSION OF BONUS QUALIFICATION


Effective March 16, 2020, Bonus Qualification was suspended Department-wide due to the COVID-19 response. It is expected that this closure will extend indefinitely. A subsequent Notice will be published when Department-wide qualification is reinstated.

Employees who are receiving bonus compensation, as provided for in Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) No. 24, Article 5.7, will have their bonus compensation extended during this time. Additionally, employees who are currently qualified at the Distinguished Expert level will have a score of 385 assigned to them for each month of the closure. Recruit officers who shoot Bonus Qualification during this time as part of their academy training will be awarded the appropriate medal and will receive compensation at that level. Employees will be required to shoot a new bonus score within 60 days of the Bonus Qualification, resuming to continue to receive their bonus compensation.

During this restricted period, Bonus Qualification will possibly be scheduled intermittently at the Davis Training Facility (DTF) or the Elysian Park (EP) Bonus Range as range resources permit. Bonus Qualification could be offered for the limited purpose of allowing those officers who wish to qualify for the 1911 Pistol Transition School and for those officers who do not possess any bonus medal the opportunity to acquire a bonus medal or upgrade existing medals.
