**TO:** Metropolitan Division Personnel

**FROM:** Commanding Officer, Metropolitan Division

**SUBJECT:** RELINQUISHMENT OF HOME GARAGING AUTHORITIES

Effective immediately, Metropolitan Division (Metro) personnel on long-term Injured on Duty (IOD) status shall relinquish their home garaged vehicle until they are returned to full duty status.

**NOTE:** For purposes of Metro, long-term will be defined as any period beyond 30 days.

Due to fiscal constraints, the availability of vehicles for use by Metro personnel has been severely limited. In an effort to sustain the operational integrity of the division, it has become necessary to critically evaluate the use of every vehicle. Home garaged vehicles are assigned to Metro personnel to facilitate their response to emergency incidents. Due to their status, personnel on long-term IOD are unable to respond to field situations therefore negating their need for a home garaged vehicle.
