SUBJECT: USE OF DESERT DIGITAL CAMOUFLAGE TRAINING UNIFORMS -
DISCONTINUED

In an effort to minimize identification concerns, the wearing of the Desert Digital Camouflage Training Uniform will be discontinued effective January 1, 2010. Commencing on January 1, 2010, all Metropolitan Division personnel shall wear the Blue Utility uniform with all identifying patches, as the uniform for training. This Order will ensure uniformity among Metropolitan Division personnel and establishes proper uniform protocol.

NOTE: When the Blue Utility top is not used, a black T-shirt with Metropolitan Division insignias on the upper sleeves, along with Department identification shall be worn.

EXCEPTION: Officers assigned to the Sniper Cadre will still be authorized to wear the Desert Digital and green camouflage fatigue uniform when operationally necessary.

Any requested deviations or exceptions to this Order will be reviewed and authorized by the Commanding Officer, Metropolitan Division.
