SUBJECT: PARKING VIOLATION CITATIONS

<u>PURPOSE</u>

The purpose of this Notice is to provide training regarding proper completion of Parking Violation Citation, Form DT 5001, issued by Department personnel.

BACKGROUND

The Los Angeles Department of Transportation (LADOT) is responsible for processing and collecting all parking violation citations. The LADOT has recently advised that the Parking Violations issued by the Department are routinely being rejected for being completed incorrectly. As a result, it has been requested that the Department provide training to improve the quality of Parking Violation Citations issued and to reduce the number of rejected citations.

DISCUSSION

The LADOT has identified the six common errors that Department personnel routinely commit that result in Parking Violations Citations being cancelled.

Issuance of "For Sale" Violations

The issuance of parking citations for vehicles displaying a "For Sale" sign is governed by Section 87.55 of the Los Angeles Municipal Code (LAMC). This LAMC section provides specific streets in the City of Los Angeles where this practice is prohibited and enforcement is authorized. Prior to issuing a "For Sale" parking citation, verify that the streets are identified in the LAMC to ensure proper enforcement.

Critical Fields Not Completed

The following fields shall be completed:

- Date
- Time

Time must be based on the 24-Hour clock (Military Time).

* License

When no license, enter Vehicle Identification Number (VIN).

Last 4 Digits of the VIN

When the last four digits cannot be obtained, write "NV" (Not Visible) in the "Note" Section of the citation.

Registration Expiration Date

Year/Month – Ensure that the year and month of the registration is listed.

Make

If the vehicle's make cannot be determined, write "UNK" (Unknown) or "OTH" (Other). Citations with a Department of Motor Vehicle make mismatch will be cancelled.

Color

If the color cannot be determined, write "UNK" (Unknown) or "OTH" (Other). Do not leave this field blank.

Location

Indicate the exact, approximate, or block that the vehicle was parked. Avoid using intersections. When providing a street address, use cardinal directions such as North, South, Fast or West and the roadway type: Avenue, Street, Court or Place.

Violation

An "X" shall be placed on the violation box and the bail amount shall be circled.

Violation Code

Should a violation not be listed, refer to the attached document for the corresponding Los Angeles Municipal Code or California Vehicle Code violation and fine amount. The violation and fine shall be entered in the "Other" field of the Violation Section of the parking citation.

Notes

Any entry in the "Notes" field shall apply to the violation and be clearly written. Violations that require observation times must be included in the notes such as Yellow, White or Green Parking Zones, Time Limits, 72 hour Violations, etc...

Double Citations

Parking Violation Citations may only contain one violation.

Make Mismatch

The make of the vehicle being cited must match the "Vehicle Make" that is circled on the Parking Violation Citation.

Handicap/Disabled Parking Citations

The Parking Violation Citation provides four subsections (A, B, C1 and C2) to select. When citing for a Handicap Space Violation, the correct subsection needs to be circled.

No Observations Times

When issuing a Parking Violation Citation resulting from a time violation, the "Note" Section needs to indicate the posted time limit.

Should it be determined that a Parking Violation Citation contains an error(s), do not attempt to correct the citation by striking through the incorrect information and writing VCC (Violator Corrected Copy) with the issuers initials. The LADOT does not recognize this as an acceptable practice.

The violator should be issued a new Parking Violation Citation and the other Parking Violation Citation needs to be voided. A Citation Cancellation Request, Form 04.45.00, shall be completed for all citations requested to be cancelled. Original Parking Violation Citations and requests for cancellations shall be sent to:

An ordinance amending Section 89.60, Chapter VIII, Division W of the Los Angeles Municipal Code to increase fines and late penalty fees imposed for violation of any regulation governing the standing or parking of a vehicle under the California Vehicle Code or other State law, Federal law, and the provisions of the Los Angeles Municipal Code and the Los Angeles Administrative Code.

THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF LOS ANGELES DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Section 89.60, Chapter VIII, Division W of the Los Angeles Municipal Code is amended to read as follows:

SEC. 89.60. AUTHORITY.

Pursuant to the authority of State law, a schedule of civil parking penalties is hereby established for the violation of any regulation governing the standing or parking of a vehicle under the California Vehicle Code or other State law, any Federal law, and provisions of the Los Angeles Municipal Code or of the Los Angeles Administrative Code. Any federal, state or local standing or parking regulation constituting a violation for which no provision is made in this schedule shall have a fine of \$63 and with late penalty of \$126 and with a second late payment penalty of \$151.

The parking fines and late payment penalties listed here for a section shall apply to all unlisted subsections.

A parking fine shall be increased by a late payment penalty if payment is received more than 14 days from the mailing date of a notice of delinquent parking violation. For the purposes of this schedule, the penalties are added to the original fine and included under the "fine with late penalty" amounts listed above.

The second late payment penalty will be applied only if payment is received more than 58 days from the date of issuance. For purposes of this schedule, the second penalty is added to the fine with penalty amount.

Any surcharges or assessments, including any penalties or other fees, mandated by State law for a violation and not included in the fine and late penalties shall be added to the fine for the violation.

A parking fee shall be increased by the current DMV charge when a hold vehicle registration renewal is placed with the Department of Motor Vehicles.

A parking fine shall be increased by the amount of the fee that is charged to the City upon assignment as a delinquent account for Special Collection processing and/or if the City assigns to an outside collection agency or independent third party collectors.

Sec. 2. The City Clerk shall certify to the passage of this ordinance and have it published in accordance with Council policy, either in a daily newspaper circulated in the City of Los Angeles or by posting for ten days in three public places in the City of Los Angeles: one copy on the bulletin board at the Main Street entrance to the Los Angeles City Hall; one copy on the bulletin board at the Main Street entrance to the Los Angeles City Hall East; and one copy on the bulletin board located at the Temple Street entrance to the Los Angeles County Hall of Records.
