Session Goal: Given a role-play scenario using simunition handguns and inert less lethal devices, the recruit officers will demonstrate sound tactics and appropriate use of force options.

Learning Objectives:

- To use the appropriate tactics for a variety of different vehicle stops.
- To demonstrate the appropriate use of force options.
- To articulate the use of force used.

- Simunition handguns painted blue, simunition barrel (M&P, Berretta, Glock)
- Colt AR-15 with simunition kit and blue stock
- Simunition FX ammunition (9mm)
- Two windowless FOF vehicles
- Windowless plain vehicle
- 8 training radios
- Inert Taser for each student participating
- Inert baton for each student participating
- Remington 870 shotgun with simunition kit and blue stock
- Safety briefing handout read and signed by all students (See attached handout)
- Eye protection for each student and instructor in the training area
- Body armor for each student participating in the Force on Force scenarios
- Authorized head and throat protection for each student participating in the Scenario
- Groin protection must be worn by each male student participating
- Long sleeves or sweatshirts mandatory

All other scenarios will be chosen from the TTU scenario book if the scenario or scenario variation allows simunition.</p>

Learning Activity 1- Vehicle pullover for an infraction (No shoot)

Purpose- Given a role-play scenario the recruit officers will demonstrate sound tactics while conducting a vehicle pullover.

Description- Officers will observe a traffic violation and broadcast all necessary information before conducting the traffic stop. The officers will use the proper traffic stop tactics while performing the stop. An instructor will act as the violator and cooperate with the officers. No shooting shall occur during the scenario.

Suspect behaviors:

- Cooperative
