S11 Officer Safety			
 They should avoid touching any substance with their hands (always wear rubber gloves), and avoid sniffing the drugs. 			
 They need to watch for exposed syringes and blood from fresh puncture wounds. 			
C. Safety precautions.			
 When dealing with suspected controlled substances, peace officers should NOT taste, smell, or touch any substance that may appear to be drugs. Wear rubber gloves when recovering narcotics. 			
 Some drugs can be absorbed through the pores of the skin, cuts, mucus membranes (transdermal), or inhaled. 			
 If needed officers should always wait for hazmat specialists in some cases to enter or recover possible narcotics. 			
 D. Officer Safety Issues with Growers 1. Growers have been known to use booby traps. 2. Are often armed. 3. Often have vicious dogs. 4. Early detection systems: alarms and/or video cameras.
