SUBJECT: HOLIDAY CLOSURES (FISCAL YEAR 2012/2013)

This notice is to advise you regarding important information that possibly concerns employees under your command.

Due to the fact that the Police Department is a 24/7 operation, the Department will not shut down during the week between Christmas Day and New Year's Day holidays. However, employees in the following MOUs (2, 3, 4, 8, 10, 12, 13, 14, 15, 17, 18, 36, 37) are entitled to 32 hours of paid time off that can be used between July 1, 2012 and June 30, 2013. Attached is a list of classifications entitled to the paid time off. In no instance can the employees' time off exceed 32 hours.

- The approved time code for the holiday time is HT.
- HT time must be taken in hourly increments.
- Time off must be requested in the same manner as vacation or a compensatory time off (CTO) day.
- HT time will be approved at the Commanding Officer's discretion based on the operational needs of the division.
- Fiscal Operations Division will distribute bi-weekly reports which will list the amount of HT time off that employees have used.


Employees covered under MOU No. 9 are subject to 36 furlough days in Fiscal Year 2012/2013. These employees are not entitled to Holiday Time.

Non-represented employees are required to take 32 hours of unpaid time during Fiscal Year 2012/2013. These hours should be coded as GN (FLSA non-exempt) or GS (Salaried) and may be taken at the discretion of the employee and management. These hours do not need to be taken during any specific period and do not need to be taken consecutively.
