SUBJECT: REVISION TO DEPARTMENT APPROVED COLD WEATHER CAP

On March 5, 2013, the Los Angeles Police Department (Department) approved a cold weather cap for uniformed personnel to wear during inclement weather conditions. The cold weather cap is still approved by the Department but is restricted to the following:

- Tru Spec Polartec cap, style number VPO-065552-1 in black with embroidered "LAPD" letters. The embroidered thread shall be Black Madera in color, color code 1800 or Madera, color code 1303. The "LAPD" letters shall be 1 inch in height and 2.9 inches in width. The "LAPD" letters shall be on the front of the cold weather cap. The bottom of the "LAPD" letters shall be 1 inch from the brim of the cold weather cap. The cap shall have no other markings, tags or logos.
- Arc of Seneca Cayuga-Finger Lakes Textiles synthetic Polartec/microfleece cap in black with the embroidered "LAPD" letters. The embroidered thread shall be Black Madera in color, color code 1800 or Madera, color code 1303. The "LAPD" letters shall be 1 inch in height and 2.9 inches in width. The "LAPD" letters shall be on the front of the cold weather cap. The bottom of the "LAPD" letters shall be 1 inch from the brim of the cold weather cap. The cap shall have no other markings, tags or logos.

Note: The cold weather cap may be worn by Department personnel in Class "A" "B" or "C" uniform or the utility uniform. The cold weather cap shall only be worn in conjunction with a Department approved jacket. The cold weather cap may not be worn while attending formal events such as, but not limited to recruit graduations, funerals and award ceremonies. Attached is an image of the LAPD lettering style.

All officers that have already purchased and/or own any of these two caps without the "LAPD" embroidery, shall have the embroidery as indicated above before wearing it in uniform and on duty. Cold weather caps are considered an optional purchase and purchased at the employee's expense.
