**SUBJECT:** TEMPORARY SUSPENSION OF QUALITY SERVICE INSPECTIONS  
UTILIZING BODY WORN VIDEO AND DIGITAL IN-CAR VIDEO


The Department strives to deliver service to our community that is professional, courteous, conforming to law and internal policies, and is delivered in a manner that is safe for our officers as well as the public. To reinforce these objectives the Department instituted a Quality Service Inspection procedure for the random inspection of Body Worn Video (BWV) and Digital In-Car Video (DICV) of our daily interactions with the public.

Recently the Department received a cease and desist demand from the Los Angeles Police Protective League (LAPPL), for the use of the Quality Service Inspections utilizing BWV and DICV, and that the Department engage the LAPPL in a meet and confer process if the Department wishes to continue this practice. On the advice of the City Attorney's Office, the Department will suspend temporarily the Quality Service Inspections and meet with the LAPPL to forge an agreement as quickly as possible.

In the meantime, the inspections that were previously agreed to and delineated in the Office of Operations Notice, Dated March 15, 2018, *STANDARDIZED VIDEO INSPECTION PROCEDURES*, shall continue without interruption.
