SUBJECT: CITATION GUIDE, FORM 16.65.00 - REVISED

The Citation Guide, Form 16.65.00, for calendar years 2017 through 2019, has been revised due to four (4) new California Vehicle Code (CVC) section updates. The obsolete and updated CVC sections are listed in the chart below for easy reference:

Obsolete CVC Sections	Updated CVC Sections
27315(d)(2) – LIMOUSINE for hire operators, emergency vehicle operators, and passengers 4 years of age or over and weighing 40 pounds or more (in front seat) are properly restrained by a safety belt.	27315(d)(3) – LIMOUSINE for hire operators, emergency vehicle operators, and passengers 8 years of age or over in the front seat are properly restrained by a safety belt.
<u>27315(d)(3)</u> – TAXICAB operator shall not operate taxicab unless any passengers 4 years of age or over and 40 pounds or more (in front seat) are properly restrained by a safety belt.	27315(d)(4) – TAXICAB operator shall not operate a taxicab unless any passengers 8 years of age or over in the front seat are properly restrained by a safety belt.
27360 – CHILD RESTRAINTS (subsections a & b apply when there is a child under 6 years of age and less than 60 lbs. (a) Parent/guardian present in vehicle each child properly using child passenger seat restraint. (b) Parent/guardian not present driver to provide that each child properly using child pass. seat restraint or seat belt.	<ul> <li><u>27360 – CHILD RESTRAINTS</u></li> <li>(a) A parent, legal guardian, or driver who transports a child under eight years of age shall properly use a child pass. seat restraint system in a rear seat that meets applicable federal motor vehicle safety standards.</li> <li>(b) Except as provided in Section 27363, a parent, legal guardian, or driver who transports a child under two years of age on a highway in a motor vehicle shall properly secure the child in a rear-facing child passenger restraint system that meets applicable federal motor vehicle safety standards, unless the child weighs 40 or more pounds or is 40 or more inches tall.</li> </ul>
<ul> <li><u>27360.5 – RESTRAINT OF OLDER</u></li> <li><u>CHILDREN</u> (subsection a &amp; b apply when a child is 6 years of age and older, but less than 16 yrs; or 60 lbs. or more in a private passenger motor vehicle)</li> <li>(a) Parent, Guardian, each child in seat belt.</li> <li>(b) Driver, (Parent/Guardian not present).</li> </ul>	<ul> <li>27360.5 - RESTRAINT OF OLDER CHILDREN (subsections a &amp; b apply when a child is 8 years of age or older, but less than 16 years of age in a private passenger motor vehicle).</li> <li>(a) Parent, Guardian, or driver each child in seat belt.</li> <li>(b) does not apply to Driver, (Parent/Guardian is present).</li> </ul>
