COMMUNITY-POLICE ADVISORY BOARD MEETINGS

EFFECTIVE: IMMEDIATELY

A survey revealed that several Community-Police Advisory
Boards (C-PAB) are not in compliance with Administrative Order
No. 6, Structure and Responsibilities of Community-Police
Advisory Boards, dated May 18, 2000. Specifically, the survey
revealed that multiple C-PAB meetings in the same Area are being
conducted specifically for youth and/or non-English speaking
community members. This Notice serves as a reminder to Area
commanding officers that each geographic Area shall have only
one C-PAB meeting, which shall meet monthly and be
representative of the community with respect to diversity of
gender, ethnicity, age, social status, and vocation.

Effective immediately, all C-PABs shall conduct only <u>one</u> general meeting that is inclusive of its entire constituency. Every effort shall be made to ensure that meeting agendas, notices, and/or other related material is available in the appropriate languages. Additionally, Areas shall make every attempt to provide foreign language assistance (translation) during the monthly C-PAB meetings to eliminate the need for separate non-English speaking meetings. The C-PAB youth sub-committee shall also be represented at the monthly C-PAB meeting and report on the sub-committee's progress, etc.
