SUBJECT: REDUCTION OF NARCOTICS ENFORCEMENT DETAIL (NED)
AUTHORITIES

To help bolster patrol efforts and ensure that Geographic Areas have the resources needed to maintain patrol operations at full staffing, the Department has determined that two Police Officer II authorities will be permanently eliminated from each Geographic Area Narcotics Enforcement Detail (NED) and transferred to patrol operations within the Area the authorities were originally assigned.

The reduction of the allotted Fixed Post positions from each Geographic Area NED will be conducted Deployment Period 3, 2018, and will be completed in accordance with established Employee Relations Group guidelines. Specifically, the two NED Police Officer II authorities will be modified as follows:

1. Unfilled or vacant authorities will be reassigned first;
2. Absent unfilled/vacant authorities, voluntary reassignment will be sought; and,
3. In the absence of either of the above options, authorities will be reassigned on a last-in, first out basis.

The affected employee will receive a 30-day Notification of Reassignment. Upon notification, the employee may submit an Employee's Report, Form 15.07, to their commanding officer requesting consideration for a preferred watch.
