SUBJECT: CLARIFICATION OF REPOSSESSION AGENCY LICENSE REQUIREMENTS REGARDING LEGAL OWNER RELEASES OF 30-DAY HOLD VEHICLES

EFFECTIVE: IMMEDIATELY

This Notice clarifies the definitions of a legal owner (L/O) and a repossession agency/agent for the purpose of obtaining a release of a vehicle on a 30-day hold. Operations Notice No. 11, Change in Law Regarding Legal Owner Releases on 30-Day Hold Vehicles, dated December 9, 2009, has been interpreted by some Area personnel as requiring a repossession agency license prior to releasing a vehicle hold. Legal owners or their agents are exempt by law from the requirement to provide a repossession agency license.

Legal Owner/Legal Owner Agent Defined: California Vehicle Code Section 14.602.6 (f)(1) defines a L/O as a motor vehicle dealer, bank, credit union, acceptance corporation or other licensed financial institution legally operating in the State, or is another person, <u>not the registered owner</u>, holding a security interest in the vehicle.

Repossession agencies/agents are required to have a vehicle repossession agency license when repossessing a vehicle and obtaining a release on a 30-day hold vehicle. Since the L/O and the L/O's agent are excluded from being a repossession agency per California Business and Professions Code Section 7500.3, the L/O or the L/O's agent are not required to have a repossession agency license to obtain a release for a vehicle on a 30-day hold.

Section 14602.6 (f) (3) of the California Vehicle Code requires that an L/O of the vehicle or the L/O's agent presents the following documents in order to obtain a release of a vehicle on a 30-day hold:

- A copy of the assignment as defined in subdivision (b) of Section 7500.1 of the California Business and Professions Code, and any <u>one</u> of the following:
- A certificate of repossession for the vehicle, <u>or</u> a security agreement for the vehicle, <u>or</u> the title showing proof of legal ownership for the vehicle.
