

SUBJECT: TRANSIT SERVICES DIVISION NOTIFICATION - REMINDER

As the Department provides police services to the City's transportation systems pursuant to its contract with the Los Angeles County Metropolitan Transportation Authority (LACMTA), it is crucial that the Transit Services Division watch commander is notified of all transit-related incidents or crimes. When Department personnel encounter any bus or rail related incident or crime, they should notify the Transit Services Division watch commander at (213) 922-1410 as soon as practicable.

Additionally, personnel are reminded to enter the proper transit-related premise codes and ensure that the transit-related boxes on all related reports are checked. See the Office of Operations Notice, *Transit-Related Premise Codes and Modus Operandi Field*, dated October 30, 2017, for detailed guidance regarding the reporting procedures for transit-related incidents.
