SUBJECT: REAL ID DRIVER'S LICENSE AND IDENTIFICATION CARD

Beginning October 1, 2020, the Federal Government will require all state Driver's Licenses (DL) and Identification Cards (ID) to be REAL ID compliant in order to board commercial airline flights, enter Federal facilities or visit military installations.

The REAL ID Act of 2005 was passed in response to the events of 9/11. The Federal compliant REAL ID DL or ID (DL/ID) are optional and are not required to drive within the state of issuance, apply for Federal benefits or receive life-saving services.

However, after October 1, 2020, only a Federally approved REAL ID DL/ID, valid United States Passport, military ID or other Transportation Security Administration (TSA) approved documentation will be accepted when passing through TSA checkpoints nationwide, entering Federal facilities or visiting military installations.

Beginning January 22, 2018, the California Department of Motor Vehicles (DMV) began issuing redesigned DL/ID cards that identify a REAL ID DL/ID compliant card (California Grizzly Bear with a star in the upper right hand corner) or a Federal Non-Compliant DL/ID card ("Federal Limits Apply" appears in right hand corner); both of which are valid forms of identification.

To apply for a REAL ID DL/ID, you must visit the DMV. Simply renewing the DL/ID online and not physically visiting the DMV, will produce a Federal Non-Compliant DL/ID card which will not allow access to Federal facilities, military installations or passage through TSA checkpoints.

Upon visiting the DMV, ensure proof of the below documentation is resubmitted:

- Identity
- California residency
- Social Security number
- Name change documentation (if applicable)

California Driver License and Identification Card Redesign

The California Department of Motor Vehicles (DMV) is redesigning the driver license and identification (DL/ID) card. Effective January 22, 2018, DMV began producing the DL/ID card with the new card design.

REAL ID Card

Marking: California Grizzly bear with a star appears in the upper right corner.

Here is a look at the card designs and some important features:

1. Gold miner image in the bottom right corner of the card.
2. California poppies appear on the bottom left of the card.
3. Under ultraviolet "UV" light, UV image of the cardholder photo, the UV image of birth date, and the UV image of the Golden Gate Bridge and Coit Tower appears.
4. New Veteran Designation design.
5. The "California" header changed.
