**SUBJECT:** REINSTATEMENT OF BONUS QUALIFICATION

Effective June 1, 2018, bonus qualification will be reinstated Department-wide.

Employees qualifying for bonus compensation prior to the closure have continued to receive compensation as provided in Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) 24, Article 5.6. Additionally, employees who qualified at the Distinguished Expert level at the time of the closure (score of 385) continued to receive the same score each month of the closure. Recruit officers who shot bonus qualification as part of their academy training, were awarded the appropriate medal and continued to receive compensation.

In order to continue receiving bonus compensation, employees will be required to shoot a new bonus score within 60 days of June 1, 2018. Bonus qualification will be offered at the Elysian Park Academy and at the Davis Training Facility as set forth in the Department Qualification Notice.
