SUBJECT: REVISION OF JAIL OPERATIONS MANUAL SECTION 2/225, REMOVAL OF AN ARRESTEE'S PERSONAL ITEMS

Recent directives by the Los Angeles Sheriff Department (LASD) relating to the intake of female arrests and the retention of bra's with underwires, requires Custody Services Division (CSD) revise its existing policy. The policy, as outlined in the Jail Operations Manual (JOM), January 2019, Rev 1.x, directs that female arrestees retain their bra if the underwire is not exposed.

Effective immediately, all female arrestee's bras with underwires are to be removed and packaged in their property bag. A sports bra shall be made available upon request. Each respective Supply Section personnel shall be responsible for ensuring a supply of sports bras are readily available. Supply Section personnel are to order Model No. EBASPLS, or similar, from Bob Barker, Inmate Clothing via a 15.11 to Supply Division.

This revised Order will be incorporated in the next Jail Operations Manual update.
