Session 2 - Square Corners
Learning Activity No 6
LD 19-Emergency Vehicle Operations Course

Purpose: This learning activity gives the students their first opportunity to apply all of the concepts concurrently that were introduced in the “Fundamental of Vehicle Control Lecture.”

Description: An EVOC instructor will demonstrate the six fundamentals of vehicle control on a pre-designated course emphasizing 90 degree turns. The instructor will conduct a “stop and talk” description at each corner to explain how the fundamentals apply. Safe errors will be emphasized (i.e., slow corner entry speeds, late “turn in” and progressive increasing input rate of steering). This exercise will be conducted at slow speeds. The student will demonstrate proper roadway position and the three essential reference points of a turning maneuver.

Each student will be provided time to demonstrate while under the supervision of an EVOC instructor positioned in the front passenger seat. The EVOC instructor will actively assess the performance and provide real time instruction to positively reinforce proper techniques or correct any deficiencies that are observed. The safety ratio of instructor to student for this exercise is 1:3.

Resources needed:

- EVOC training vehicles
- Police radios
- Cones

Key learning points

- The student will understand how to apply the fundamentals of vehicle control
- Demonstrate proper roadway position and the three essential reference points of a turning maneuver (**LD 19. IV. E**).
