Session 5 - Post Pursuit Intervention Technique Vehicle Deployment (PIT)
Learning Activity No. 24
LD 19 Emergency Vehicle Operations Course

Purpose: This learning activity affords the student the opportunity to practice deploying the second and third vehicles after a PIT has occurred.

Description: EVOC instructors will explain the post PIT vehicle deployment which will include the completion of a successful PIT followed by the deployment of the second and third vehicles. Students will be instructed on how to place the second vehicle at the front of the suspect's vehicle (which has been turned 180 degrees) and how the third vehicle will offset on the left or right side depending on which side provides the best advantage to prevent the suspect from driving away. Each student will receive an appropriate amount of time to practice this deployment by driving either as the second or third vehicles or both. However, all students will have the opportunity to be in both vehicles during the exercise. During this practical application, EVOC instructors located in the front passenger seats of both the second and third vehicles, will actively assess the student's performance and provide real time instruction to reinforce proper techniques or correct any deficiencies that are observed. EVOC Instructors will drive the suspect and primary vehicles (PIT vehicles). The instructor to student safety ratio is 6:12.

Resources needed:

- EVOC training PIT vehicles
- Police radios
- Cones

Key learning points

- Students will be able to tactically deploy the second and third vehicles after a PIT has occurred.
- Demonstrate proper throttle control and braking (**LD 19 IV. D.**)

Minimum Proficiency: The student must demonstrate the ability to properly deploy the second and/or third vehicles after a PIT has been used.

Time required: 30 minutes
