
The purpose of this correspondence is to inform Department personnel that the Department's Emergency Operations Guide (EOG) has been revised and updated, and is now available on the Department's Local Area Network (LAN). In addition to the updated EOG, the newly created Seasonal and Pandemic Influenza and Annex has also been added to the Department LAN.

The Department's EOG was created in 1992 and had not been revised since it was first produced. In an effort to bring the Department up to date with current emergency management procedures, the Department EOG has been updated and revised to be consistent with current national standards. The National Incident Management System and Incident Command System has been incorporated into the revised EOG, along with other emergency procedures and response strategies.


The Seasonal and Pandemic Influenza Annex is a document that was created to address issues related to health emergencies including the current H1N1 influenza pandemic. This Annex contains information and procedures to be initiated during a community health emergency where the community and Department resources may be affected. The Seasonal and Pandemic Influenza Annex is to be utilized as a supplemental document to the EOG. This Annex can be found on the Department LAN under "References, Guides, Emergency Operations Guide."
