SUBJECT: STANDING PLANS TRAINING


To ensure that Department supervisory personnel are aware and able to implement the procedures and practices related to their Area's Standing Plans, members of the Emergency Preparedness Unit (EPU), Emergency Operations Division (EOD), will be providing spontaneous training sessions. These training sessions will focus on the array of situations detailed within each Area's Standing Plans.

Personnel assigned to EPU will select random Area supervisory personnel based on their availability, at unspecified dates and times, at their Area of assignment. The training will take no prior preparation on behalf of the involved Areas and will be done in a timely and effective manner to ensure that routine Area operations are not impacted. The training will be accomplished in such manner as to ensure that the involved supervisors will have an improved understanding of the Standing Plan material and in the event of a real world situation, be able to effectively put into practice or when necessary, direct his or her subordinates in an effective manner. By discussing and practicing events (i.e. Fall back procedures, Modular Automatic Number Identification/Automatic Location Identification Retrieval system (M.A.A.R.S.) activation, Earthquake Operations and Brush Fire Evacuation) before there is an actual need, it can be assured that the Department will be better prepared to support ourselves and in turn support the communities we serve.
