SUBJECT: WIRELESS INTERNET ACCESS IN AREA ROLL CALL AND REPORT WRITING ROOMS

Keeping with the Department's 2019-2021 Strategic Plan goal of *Modernize Technology*, Information Technology Bureau (ITB) has installed and is now providing wireless internet access (WIFI) at all geographical Area and traffic command Roll Call and Report Writing rooms.

Effective immediately, Department personnel can access the internet via the "Guest_5-0" WIFI network by logging in with their Department email address and Local Area Network password.

Additionally, over the course of the next year, with the assistance of the Los Angeles Police Foundation, the Department will be expanding the coverage of the WIFI network, providing access over an expanded area in each geographical Area and traffic command. Additional network configurations will also provide enhanced access to internet for both Department employees as well as the community while inside these facilities.
