SUBJECT: NEW COMMAND PILOT REQUIREMENTS

This Notice announces changes in the requirements for applicants interested in the position of Command Pilot, Police Officer II+6, as previously established by Air Support Division.


Each applicant must comply with the following requirements:

1. Five (5) years as a sworn member of the Los Angeles Police Department;
2. Three (3) years of which shall be recent field experience (e.g. patrol, accident investigation, traffic enforcement, vice, narcotics, etc.);
3. Hold a Private Pilot License (Airplane or Rotorcraft) or have 5 years as a winged Tactical Flight Officer; and
4. Passed the Rotorcraft Private or Commercial Pilot written examination.

Additionally:

- A. Each applicant will participate in an oral evaluation of law enforcement and general aviation knowledge and be placed in a pool list.
- B. Only the highest ranking applicants in the pool list will be invited to attend a one month loan consisting of helicopter ground school and 1 to 3 hours of helicopter flight training.
- C. As positions become available, the most successful candidates will be selected to transfer to Air Support Division to attend Command Pilot Training.
