SUBJECT: OPERATIONAL SECURITY (OPSEC) ISSUES

In light of recent terrorist events, Air Support Division (ASD) has received many inquiries from professional aviation publications requesting information regarding ASD capabilities, i.e., cameras, FLIR, FASTROPE, shooting platforms, aircraft interdiction procedures, etc.

All ASD personnel are reminded that once we discuss our capabilities with publishers or writers, etc., we compromise our ability to effectively do our job should the need arise.

It is appropriate to share information with other law enforcement agencies who have a need to know and a right to know, **not** with the general aviation community.

Effective immediately, all ASD personnel shall contact either the ASD Commanding Officer or Assistant Commanding Officer prior to discussing ASD capabilities with any general aviation publication.
