Nominations should include the following:

- The officer's length of service and a short biography;
- Any other pertinent information, including attachments detailing projects/programs that the nominated reserve officer has been instrumental in developing and/or implementing, and
- A recent eight by ten inch color photograph of the concerned officer. The officer shall be photographed in a Class "A" uniform or business attire.

## All submissions to the Reserve Unit, CODD, shall be made electronically containing the above described information. Please email to LAPDReserves@lapd.online.

Bureau Commanding Officers shall review Area/Divisional Reserve Officer of the Year nominees from within their chain of command and select a "Bureau Reserve Officer of the Year." Once Bureau Commanding Officers have made their selections, the Reserve Officer of the Year Selection Committee will review the bureau submissions and select a "Department Reserve Officer of the Year – 2020."

Note: For entities that do not have a bureau in their chain of command, the concerned group, Area or Divisional Reserve Officer of the Year will be considered by the Reserve Officer of the Year Selection Committee when selecting the overall Reserve Officer of the Year – 2020.
