**SUBJECT:** EMERGENCY PREPAREDNESS SURVEYS


The Emergency Preparedness Unit (EPU), Emergency Operations Division (EOD), will be conducting emergency preparedness interviews and surveys at the geographic bureaus and Areas, beginning in May 2011. The purpose is to evaluate the readiness level of individual officers and supervisors in the event they may be required to respond to a major disaster or emergency.

In accordance with the Department's Emergency Plan, dated January 12, 2011, the Department is responsible for ensuring personnel are trained in emergency preparedness, response and recovery. Supervisors and officers will be randomly selected and asked a series of questions regarding Department policies and procedures, as well as their individual preparedness. The surveys are anonymous and will be used to assess any training and preparedness gaps.
