SUBJECT: AIR SUPPORT DIVISION RIDE-ALONG AUCTIONS FOR CHARITABLE ORGANIZATIONS

Counter-Terrorism and Special Operations Bureau (CTSOB) will allow the auction of one ride-along per year for each division within the Department. All requests shall be submitted on an Intradepartmental Correspondence, Form 15.2, to the Commanding Officer, CTSOB. The request shall be submitted no later than two months prior to the date of the auction event.


Requirements: The auction of an Air Support Division (ASD) ride-along will be considered only if the following conditions are met:

- Auctions will be allowed for charitable purposes only;
- Commanding Officers requesting the auction of a ride-along for a second party entity must show that the entity is an established 501 (c) 3 under the IRS Federal Tax Code;
- The Commanding Officer must articulate the benefits to be gained for the Department by granting the ride-along to the entity for auction.

Fulfillment of these requirements does not guarantee approval of the request. Factors that may affect approval are ASD deployment and operational needs.
