SUBJECT: CALIFORNIA INSTRUCTION PERMIT RENAMED CALIFORNIA
COMMERCIAL LEARNER'S PERMIT


The California Department of Motor Vehicles (DMV) has renamed the Commercial Instruction Permit to the Commercial Learner's Permit (CLP). Until programming modifications are completed, the document will still read Commercial Instruction Permit. In addition, the DMV has implemented the following new restrictions for any individual issued a CLP:

- Applicant must be at least 18 years of age;
- The CLP is only valid when accompanied with a valid California Driver License, minimum being a Class C Non-Commercial;
- The CLP is valid for a maximum of 180 days from the date of issuance and may be renewed for up to an additional 180 days provided that the CLP expiration date does not exceed a period of one-year from the initial application date;
- A CLP driver must be accompanied by a driver with a Commercial Driver License of the appropriate class and endorsements necessary for operating a Commercial Motor Vehicle;
- A CLP driver is limited to Tank (N), Passenger (P), and/or School Bus (S) endorsements;
- A CLP with an "N" endorsement may only operate an empty tank vehicle; and,
- A CLP with a "P" and/or "S" endorsement is prohibited from operating a Commercial Motor Vehicle with passengers other than Federal/State auditors and inspectors, test examiners, other trainees, and a properly licensed commercial driver.

Purpose

To provide information to law enforcement regarding changes to the commercial instruction permit.

Background

In accordance with federal regulations, changes were made to the commercial instruction permit and issuance process.

New Information

Effective immediately, the commercial instruction permit has been renamed the commercial learner's permit (CLP). Until programming modifications are completed, the document will still read commercial instruction permit. See attachment for a sample of a completed CLP and list of new restriction codes. The CLP:

- Applicant must be at least 18 years of age
- Is only valid when accompanied by the CLP holder's valid California driver license (DL), minimum being a Class C noncommercial
- Is valid for a maximum of 180 days from the date of issuance and may be renewed for up to an additional 180 days, provided the CLP expiration date does not exceed a period of one-year from the initial application date
- Holder must be accompanied by a commercial DL holder of the appropriate class license and endorsements necessary for operating a commercial motor vehicle (CMV)
- Is limited to Tank (N), Passenger (P), and/or School Bus (S) endorsements
- Holder with a CLP containing an "N" endorsement is prohibited from operating a tank vehicle unless empty
- Holder with a CLP containing a "P" and/or "S" endorsements is prohibited from operating a CMV with passengers, other than federal/state auditors and inspectors, test examiners, other trainees, and the accompanying commercial DL holder

NOTE: Doubles/Triples (T) and HAZMAT (H) endorsements are prohibited.

New Restriction Codes

New alpha restriction codes may be listed on the CLP and/or commercial DL.

NOTE: Not all the restrictions will appear on the driver record. Alpha restrictions codes will not be listed on temporary/interim commercial DL documents.

Restriction Code	CDLIS Code	Description
25	V	Federal variance required (CLP and CDL)
40	K	Self Certification – CDL intrastate only (CLP and CDL)
*42	M	May not operate Class A passenger vehicles (CLP and CDL)
48	L	Limited to vehicles without air brakes when driving commercially (CLP and CDL)
*49	N	May not operate Class A or B passenger vehicles (CLP and CDL)
*60	O	Restricted from operating a tractor-trailer combination connected by a fifth wheel (CDL only)
*61	Z	May not operate a full air brake equipped vehicle (CDL only)
64	E	Class A/B limited to vehicles with automatic transmission (CDL only)
66	P	Restricted from operating a CMV bus with passengers (CLP only)
70	X	Restricted from operating a CMV tank vehicle with cargo (CLP only)
*Restriction will not be reflected on the driver license record. Restriction 50 will be used to capture the restriction(s) until programming modifications are complete.		
Restriction Code 67 (May not drive in interstate commerce) is used if the applicant is not medically qualified for operating in interstate commerce and will show a "K" restriction code.		
Restriction Code 40 is used if the CLP/CDL holders who self-certify as Non-Excepted Intrastate (NA) drivers.		
Restriction Code 60 is used if the applicant performs his/her skills tests in a Class A combination CMV with the power unit (tractor) and the towed unit (trailer) connected with a pintle hook or other non-fifth wheel connection.
