DIVISIONAL ORDER NO. 02-16

SUBJECT: WEARING OF THE CRYE UTILITY

PURPOSE: This Order establishes the policy for Emergency Services Division (ESD) personnel for the wearing of the Crye Utility Uniform.

PROCEDURE: The Commanding Officer, ESD, has approved the wearing of the Crye Utility uniform shirt and pant, black in color, by ESD personnel as an optional duty uniform.

All Hazardous Devices/Materials Technicians, Bomb Detection K9 personnel, and Logistics personnel assigned to ESD are authorized to wear the Crye Utility uniform shirt as an optional duty uniform on a daily basis. The Crye Utility shirt shall be marked in accordance with Department standards (see below) and a black t-shirt with a round crew neck collar shall be worn under the Crye Utility shirt.

Identification/Markings

Crye Utility shirts shall be marked in accordance with the Uniform and Personal Equipment Specifications Manual Part 1: Sworn Personnel, Section F: Utility Suit. The shirt shall have the section/unit shoulder patches affixed on the sleeve pockets with Velcro. The words "LOS ANGELES", measuring ½-inch high, shall be centered on top and the word "POLICE", measuring 5/8-inch high, shall be centered underneath it on the left chest. Name lettering shall be ½ inch high centered on the right chest. All lettering shall be in dull silver. Supervisors wearing the Crye Utility shirt shall attach the appropriate Department color metal or embroidered chevrons or bars to the shirt collar.

At no time will the Crye utility be worn in place of the approved Class A or Class C uniform when these uniforms are mandated or directed by the respective Officer-in-Charge.
