SUBJECT: HARDSHIP REQUESTS

Hardships have always been considered by this commanding officer on an individual basis. Hardships are granted with the understanding that the need is temporary and efforts will be made to alter circumstances to allow for the return to an open deployment pool. There will be a balance for operational deployment needs to ensure we continue providing effective service to the Department and the City.

Given the significant number of requests and the impact on deployment, the commanding officer is placing all Air Support Division (ASD) sworn personnel on notice that all hardships will be rescinded by the first day of Deployment Period (DP) 6, 2015, specifically, on Sunday, May 17, 2015.

As such, anyone desiring a hardship to be considered for DP 6 and beyond will be required to submit a properly completed 15.07 to the commanding officer. Be prepared to have a plan prior to the end of the hardship to cover a three DP-period. Operational needs and hardships will be revisited every DP for progress. After three DPs the hardship may be concluded at the discretion of the commanding officer.
