

SUBJECT: PROHIBITION OF ELECTRONIC SMOKING DEVICES IN THE AIRCRAFT

Following a discussion during an Air Support Division (ASD)'s Supervisors meeting, a safety of flight incident was brought to my attention in regards to electronic smoking devices. Based on recent public incidents, these devices have exploded in the hands, pockets and/or carrying device of the user. As a result of these potential hazards explosive devices, I have determined that they shall not be allowed in any ASD aircraft under no circumstances.

Effective immediately, no electronic smoking devices are allowed in a Department aircraft, either by any ASD personnel and/or by any individual on a fly-along. In addition, all ASD personnel are reminded to review Special Order No. 7, dated April 8, 2016, titled, "USE OF CHEWING TOBACCO AND SNUFF-REVISED; AND, SMOKING POLICY-REVISED."
