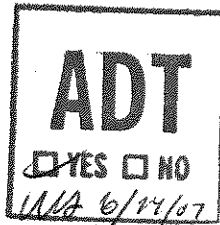

SUBJECT: DAILY REPORTING OF GANG CRIMES

EFFECTIVE: IMMEDIATELY

Accountability and relentless follow up is the key to COMPSTAT. As we focus on gang crime it is imperative that we accurately report and track gang statistics on a daily basis. Therefore, every business day, all Areas shall update the CALGANG system with incoming gang crime reports and reconcile CALGANG with the Consolidated-Crime Analysis Database (C-CAD) to ensure that gang related crime is properly reported.

Daily updates will allow for more timely tracking of gang crime, a component that is critical to the targeting of our limited resources on emerging gang problems. History has shown that when we use our crime information in a timely fashion, there is a reduction in crime. Daily tracking of gang crime will help us reach our goal to make Los Angeles the safest big city in the United States.

Each Area was assigned a person to work as a Gang Crime Analyst when the Gang Impact Team (GIT) was created. While some of these positions are performing additional duties, their primary duty is to provide crime analysis support to the GIT.
