SUBJECT: SAFE RETURN TO SCHOOL MEETING, 1996 FALL SEMESTER

PURPOSE


During the past several years, just prior to the onset of the traditional Fall school semester, the Department, in conjunction with the Los Angeles Unified School District (LAUSD), has held Safe Return to School kick-off meetings. The purpose of this collaborative effort is to maximize the protection afforded to returning students and facilitate the cooperation of those agencies responsible for preventing disruption or criminal activity on or near school campuses. Due to the success of previous meetings, it has been decided to hold a similar meeting in order to continue our efforts and ensure that children who will be returning to school for the 1996 Fall Semester can do so safely.

INFORMATION

To assist in this overall endeavor, you are invited to a meeting at the Police Academy lounge on September 5, 1996, at 0900 hours. Police Commission President Raymond Fisher and the Chief of Police will represent the Department at this meeting. School Superintendent Sid Thompson will be representing the LAUSD. Additionally, Mayor Riordan, Councilmember Chick, Sheriff Sherman Block, as well as the Chiefs of Police from cities that service the LAUSD, have been invited to attend.
