SUBJECT: UNIFORMED FIELD INCENTIVE FOR CRASH POSITIONS

EFFECTIVE: Immediately


PURPOSE

This Notice reminds Office of Operations (O.O.) Area and bureau commanding officers (COs) of the existing policy that pertains to police officers assigned to Community Resources Against Street Hoodlums (CRASH) positions being eligible for the Uniformed Field Assignment Incentive.

INFORMATION

As outlined in the Office of the Chief of Police Notice dated March 2, 1995, all CRASH positions **except** for detectives assigned to CRASH, are eligible for the uniformed field assignment bonus. Those officers loaned to any non-uniformed assignment for a period in excess of two deployment periods, are **NOT** eligible for the uniformed field assignment incentive.

NOTE: It is the responsibility of each bureau/Area CO to ensure that the Police Field Assignment Bonus roster is accurate and reflects any changes in officers' assignment status.
