## SUBJECT: NOTIFICATION OF LOAN TO A TRAFFIC DIVISION

The Department is fully committed to the successful implementation of the 2014 Traffic Plan, specifically as it relates to providing a safe environment for the communities we serve. Based on an increase in 2013, of both "A" and "K" traffic collision within the City of Los Angeles, the Director has decided to loan personnel within the Office of Operations (OO) geographic Areas to the traffic division. This movement of personnel embraces the Department core value of "Service to our Community" as it is done with a purpose to reduce "A" and "K" injury traffic collisions by 10% in 2014.

On December 23, 2013, the first phase of the 2014 Traffic Plan was implemented when the Director, OO, directed each Patrol Commanding Officer (CO) to designate specific personnel within their respective commands to be loaned to the respective bureau traffic division for a six month timespan. The first phase became effective January 26, 2014, Deployment Period 2-2014, when officers from the 21 geographic Areas were selected and officially loaned to the traffic Division. As we approach the end of the first phase, which will complete the first six month of the 2014 Traffic Plan, we embark on the second phase which will commence on August 10, 2014, Deployment Period 9-2014.

To continue the positive momentum the Department has achieved by implementing the 2014 Traffic Plan, once again a portion of our patrol officers within the 21 geographic Areas will be selected by their commanding officers for a loan to their respective traffic division. This loan will be on a rotating basis for a minimum of six months. While at traffic, you will be given additional information regarding your work assignment and mission by the traffic division commanding officers or his/her designee. Your cooperation and achieve participation will be key in achieving success in this endeavor.
