SUBJECT: CLARIFICATION OF THE 30-DAY HOLD TIMELINE FOR  
VEHICLE IMPOUNDS


EFFECTIVE: Immediately

In accordance with California Vehicle Code (CVC) Section 14602.6, any person operating a motor vehicle with a suspended or revoked driver's license, or without ever having been issued a driver's license, is eligible to have their vehicle impounded for a 30-day hold. This Notice clarifies the 30-day hold timeline for vehicle impounds.

Upon determining that the driver of a vehicle is in violation of 14602.6 CVC, the vehicle shall be impounded for 30 days. The 30-day hold shall begin on the calendar day that the hold was issued. The hold shall not be released until after the completion of the 30<sup>th</sup> day.

**Example:** If a vehicle is impounded on January 1, 2006 at 2300 hours, that would be day-one of the 30-day hold, therefore the 30<sup>th</sup> day would be completed on January 30, 2006 at 2359 hours, making the vehicle eligible for release commencing January 31, 2006 at 0001 hours.
