

SUBJECT:

CONFLICT BETWEEN NEW 7-DIGIT RELEASE FROM CUSTODY FORM NUMBER AND 6-DIGIT STOP SYSTEM PORTABLE OFFICER

DATA DEVICE SYSTEM LIMITATION

EFFECTIVE: IMMEDIATELY

It has been brought to the Department's attention that there is a conflict between the new 7-digit Release From Custody (RFC) form number, and the 6-digit STOP System/Portable Officer Data Device System (PODDS) number. Currently, neither the STOP system, nor the PODDS system will accept a 7-digit number input in the citation field. As a result, citation numbers will be invalid.

The Information Technology Division (ITD) is currently working with technology vendors to modify the STOP and PODDS systems.

In the interim, if a motor vehicle stop and/or a pedestrian stop results in the issuance of a Nontraffic Notice to Appear, Form No. 5.2.2, the associated Field Data Report (FDR), Form No. 15.43.01, shall be completed on the paper FDR form. The FDR shall then be forwarded to Civil Rights Integrity Division (CRID) for processing.
