SUBJECT: ACCEPTANCE OF BAIL FOR ARRESTEES WITH AN IMMIGRATION

DETAINER

As a reminder jail personnel will accept bail on an open charge for individuals subject to an Immigration Detainer - Notice of Action (IDNA) issued by the Department of Homeland Security, Immigration and Customs Enforcement (ICE). Individuals with an IDNA who post bail will continue to be held in custody for the IDNA for an additional 48-hours after bail or bond has been posted, excluding weekends and holidays. If ICE has not picked up the arrestee within the allotted 48-hours, the arrestee shall be released from custody. Personnel are not to hold arrestees on an IDNA beyond the 48-hours.

The Decentralized Automated Booking Information System (DABIS) will continue to be updated to indicate "no bail" to reflect the existence of the IDNA Hold. Persons requesting to post bail shall be advised that an arrestee with a Hold, will not be eligible for release if ICE picks up the arrestee, or for 48-hours, excluding weekends and holidays, after the bail or bond has been accepted. After bail/bond has been posted, ICE shall be notified the arrestee has posted bail on the open charge and will be released in 48-hours if the arrestee is not picked up before then. The employee accepting bail will update the "additional charges" section in DABIS to indicate the date and time the individual will be available for release and update the Bailed Out/ICE Due Out List.

Should ICE not pick up the arrestee, the arrestee is to be released (since bail or bond has been posted). Arrestees that have been bailed or bonded out but still have the IDNA pending, shall not be placed on LASD court transportation bus. After ICE has picked up the arrestee, DABIS shall be updated indicating the arrestee was released to ICE. If the 48-hours period expires and ICE does not pick up the arrestee, the arrestee is to be released on their bail/bond and DABIS is to be updated indicating that the arrestee was released on bail/bond.
