SUBJECT: OLYMPIC AREA PROPERTY ROOM CLOSURE

Please be advised that effective DP2, 2015, the Olympic Property Room will be temporarily shuttered until further notice. Olympic officers requiring booking of evidence and non-evidence items are directed to Central Property Section (CPS), located in the Basement of the Metropolitan Detention Center. CPS is open Sunday through Friday, 2330-1600 hours.

Every effort should be made to book property and evidence during open business hours, as Property Division employees are available to assist officers with reports and corrections. During closed business hours, interim storage lockers are available in the CPS lobby. Officers should complete the Property Division Booking Record, LAPD Form 10.04.00. To reduce the number of kickbacks and avoid booking delays, watch commanders are reminded to ensure accuracy of property reports prior to use of the interim storage lockers.

Evidence requiring analysis (e.g., firearms, narcotics, blood, urine, sexual assault evidence kits) may continue to be booked in the interim storage lockers located in the Watch Commander's Office. This evidence will generally be couriered nightly, Sunday through Thursday.

During closed business hours, questions regarding large items that will not fit into storage lockers, high value bookings, and large narcotic bookings (over 30 pounds), should be directed to the Property Division on-call supervisor, at (213) 280-3073 or through RACR Division at (213) 484-6700.

To schedule an appointment to retrieve, sign-out, sign-in, or release property and evidence housed at Olympic Area, please contact the Area Supervisor at (310) 213-7153. Every attempt will be made to honor requests for service within 48 hours. Please plan accordingly.
