ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER NO. 6

SUBJECT: INTERNAL AFFAIRS GROUP – DEACTIVATED, INTERNAL AFFAIRS DIVISION – ACTIVATED; PROFESSIONAL STANDARDS BUREAU – REVISED; AND, FORCE INVESTIGATION GROUP – DEACTIVATED, FORCE INVESTIGATION DIVISION – ACTIVATED

PURPOSE: The City's recent budgetary crisis has resulted in the need to restructure Professional Standards Bureau (PSB). The command structure of PSB will now consist of the Commanding Officer (CO) and Assistant Commanding Officer (ACO). The changes to Professional Standards Bureau will be effective Deployment Period No. 5 –2021 and are delineated below.

PROCEDURE:

I. INTERNAL AFFAIRS GROUP – DEACTIVATED, INTERNAL AFFAIRS DIVISION – ACTIVATED. Internal Affairs Group (IAG) is deactivated and will be absorbed by PSB as Internal Affairs Division (IAD). Internal Affairs Division will assume the duties of Administrative Investigation Division and Criminal Investigation Division. As a result, IAD will be comprised of the following sections:

- Workplace Investigation Section;
- Complaint Investigation Section – Central;
- Complaint Investigation Section – South;
- Complaint Investigation Section – Valley;
- Complaint Investigation Section – West; and,
- Complaint Investigation Section – Support.

The reference numbers for IAD will be 13.5. All unit designations remain the same.

II. PROFESSIONAL STANDARDS BUREAU – REVISED. The command structure of PSB will now consist of the CO and ACO. Due to the re-structure, PSB will consist of the newly established IAD, Force Investigation Division (FID), and Special Operations Division (SOD). Both IAD and FID are realigned under the ACO, PSB. Special Operations Division shall continue to remain a direct report to the CO, PSB. In addition, a Captain II Authority has been added to FID, and is assigned as the ACO. A Captain II Authority has been added to IAD and is assigned as the ACO.

III. FORCE INVESTIGATION GROUP – DEACTIVATED, FORCE INVESTIGATION DIVISION – ACTIVATED. Force Investigation Group is deactivated, and will be absorbed by PSB as FID. The Reference Numbers and the Unit Designation Numbers will remain the same.

AMENDMENTS: The Organization Chart and the Organization and Functions of the Los Angeles Police Department links on the Department's Local Area Network will be updated accordingly to reflect the above changes.

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AUDIT RESPONSIBILITY: The CO, Audit Division, shall review this directive and determine whether an audit or inspection shall be conducted in accordance with Department Manual Section 0/080.30.
