

SUBJECT: POTENTIAL IMPACT OF UNITED TEACHERS LOS ANGELES STRIKE ON DEPARTMENT EMPLOYEES

The United Teachers Los Angeles (UTLA) has indicated that a district-wide strike will be called on January 10, 2019, if the Los Angeles Unified School District (LAUSD) and UTLA are unable to reach a labor agreement. Though the strike may have a significant impact on our employees whose children attend LAUSD schools, the mission of the Los Angeles Police Department remains unchanged – we are each tasked with preserving the safety of the City of Los Angeles and its residents.

All Department employees who may be adversely impacted by the strike are encouraged to begin making alternative childcare arrangements so that they can continue to report to their scheduled shifts for the duration of the strike. Those employees who have exigent circumstances which will prevent them from securing alternative childcare shall submit an Employee's Report, Form 15.07.00, to their commanding officer. The 15.07.00 shall provide a brief narrative outlining which projected dates during the strike the employee will be unable to report to work. The commanding officer shall review the report and make final a determination based on deployment needs.
